### Architectural Design 01<sup>st</sup> Year

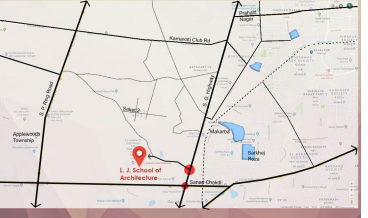
