He is a widely published commentator on South Asian and China—Tibet affairs.

Along with his distinguished journalism expertise, Mayank Chhaya, is also a renowned author, known for his notable literary works. His acclaimed book, "The Dalai Lama: Man, Monk, and Mystic," stands as the sole authorised biography of the revered spiritual leader authored by a non-Buddhist, published in 24 languages around the world. Additionally, Chhaya's insightful biography, "Sam Pitroda: A Biography" (1992), delves into the life of the visionary behind India's technological revolution in the 1980s.

Key Learnings Shared:

Drawing from his rich tapestry of experiences, Mayank Chhaya imparted invaluable wisdom on the fundamental tenets of journalism. Emphasising the inherent human-centric nature of journalism, he underscored the ethical imperative of impartiality and objectivity. His elucidation of four cardinal principles of journalism - centred on human existence, neutrality, independence from personal bias, and the preservation of credibility - resonated deeply with the audience.

Anecdotal Reflections and Inspirational Journey:

Mayank Chhaya's narrative journey into the realm of journalism, marked by seminal moments such as his early inspiration from "the odessa file" and his formative years at the Free Press Journal in Bombay at the beginning of 1980s, provided a captivating backdrop for his insights. His anecdotal reflections illuminated the transformative power of journalism in shaping societal narratives and catalysing change.

Advocacy for Emerging Technologies and Lifelong Learning:

In addition to his discourse on traditional journalistic values, the veteran championed the integration of emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence into journalistic practices. While acknowledging the transformative potential of AI, he emphasised the indispensable role of field reporting in preserving the authenticity and depth of journalistic narratives. Furthermore, his advocacy for fostering a culture of regular reading and writing underscored the enduring significance of foundational skills in journalistic excellence.


